

Examining Word Parts: Suffixes

A **suffix** is a group of letters added to the end of a base word to change the word's meaning or part of speech.

The suffixes -ion, -tion, and -ation mean "condition or process of."

The suffix -ment means "act or process of."

Adding either of these suffixes to a word changes it from a verb to a noun.
